Geography Southwest is a brand new website developed by an enthusiastic group of geographers in SW England. It aims to provide a wide range of geography resources to support geography education in the SW and beyond.

The website will comprise a number of distinctive pages including primary geography, secondary geography, geography at university, fieldwork and CPD. In addition, there will be pages focusing on visiting the SW, exploring the SW (using interactive GIS) and a page specifically focusing on climate change. Resources will be generated by teachers, university departments (e.g. UWE, Plymouth and Cambridge) and public/private organisations (e.g. Wildfowl and Wetlands Trust and the Environment Agency). For all concerned, the website represents an opportunity to increase awareness, engagement and exposure.

Our audience will comprise geography teachers and students across the UK and beyond at all levels (primary through to university); there is no other website like geography southwest!

Additionally, we expect our Visit SW pages to attract members of the public keen to explore the SW; we will have sections on places to visit, places to eat and places to stay. Collectively, this is a huge potential market of like-minded people . . . geography focused but interested in exploration, conservation, the environment and the 'great outdoors'.
